





Table tennis may be one of the most popular indoor sports in the world. It's played in every country across the world by both young and old people. It doesn't cost as much money as other sports, and it's easy to start playing. You can learn the rules quickly and soon be playing with your friends, although the game is difficult to master.

The origins of the game date back to a living-room game that was popular in the late 19th century in England. Players hit a *¹champagne cork with a book, back and forth across a large dinner table separated in half by a row of books. From the sounds the 'ball' made, the game was named "*²Ping Pong." Tennis lovers played it on rainy days or during the winter. The table became a kind of indoor tennis court. Maybe that's why tables made for ping pong were basically green like grass courts until 1992.

By the 1920s, there were thousands of players all over Europe, and it became necessary to make some proper rules. So the International Table Tennis *3Federation was formed in 1926. By that time the balls and rackets were almost the same as the ones used today.

Today's table tennis needs fast reactions and the players have to be physically strong. With famous players and colorful uniforms, it's become one of the most popular games in the Olympics.
