



John Mole teaches how to understand *'nonverbal communication. He is a body language (a). He knows how to read it and how to use it. In his book, he explains how your body language can communicate your interest in what you are hearing or seeing. (b), when you *2lean forward toward a speaker, you communicate that you want to hear what the speaker is saying. However, when you lean back and cross your arms, you're showing that you're not interested.

Body language can also show whether a listener agrees or disagrees with the speaker. If you sit with your arms and legs uncrossed, you probably agree with the speaker. (\odot), crossing your arms and legs usually means that you do not agree.

Mole also teaches how to (@) the nonverbal messages that people send with their eyes, feet, and head. For example, a woman with her head to one side and her eyes open is communicating that she is thinking about what the speaker is saying. If someone looks off to the side (@) he is speaking, you may want to check the information he gives you. This type of body language can mean that the speaker isn't telling the truth.
