





Alexander Graham Bell was a scientist and *linventor. He was born in Scotland and moved to Canada. Later he lived in the U.S. He was called "Aleck" by his family and close friends. As a child, he liked testing out new things. He was interested in how people *2communicate and wanted to find a way for people in different places to speak to each other. In 1876, he made a machine to do this. The first person he spoke to was his assistant. He said, "Mr. Watson, come here. I want to see you." Bell had invented the telephone — now he had to work on his design to make it better. Within ten years, around 150,000 homes in the U.S. had telephones. Bell believed that one day people speaking on the phone would be able to see each other too. This has come true. We don't know if Bell ever imagined everyone would have a phone like a small computer.


