“As I served my cabbage to the guests and they thanked me for helping them, I knew I could and should do more to help people,” said Katie. That day her dream was born. She decided to grow vegetables to donate them to people in need. Katie started Katie’s Krops, a <sup>\*3</sup>non-profit organization. Today, it has 100 vegetable gardens in the US. Her idea has made the lives of thousands of people better. Katie’s <sup>\*4</sup>mission in life is simple: to help others.


