

"It is never too late to start new things." This is certainly true of Wakamiya Masako, an 87-year-old programmer. She *¹developed a smartphone game *²app, "Hinadan" in 2017. Because of this, she was invited to a big meeting called the *³WWDC in the US. There, Apple *⁴CEO Tim Cook introduced Wakamiya as "the oldest *⁵developer." The day before the meeting, she had a chance to talk with him. Tim said to her, "You really *6inspired me."

Wakamiya was born in Tokyo. After she finished high school, she started working for a major bank. Just before she *7retired at the age of 60, she bought a computer. While caring for her mother at home, she spent time learning online and enjoyed the Internet.

She was over 80 when she started developing game apps herself. She bought some books to try programming. When she didn't understand something, she asked people for advice through the Internet.

"At the age of 60 my world became wider. I got wings!" she says.


