






Ed Jackson was a professional *1rugby player, but in 2017 he had an accident while *2 diving into a swimming pool. Afterwards he couldn't move his body from the shoulders down. Doctors told him that he'd probably never walk again, but Ed didn't want to believe this. He was hoping to get married to a woman he knew. He said she was the main reason he wanted to recover. While in the hospital, he met Nasser, another man who had been told he would never walk again. Ed *3 encouraged him not to give up. Six months later, Nasser was walking with a *4 cane.

Only a year after his accident, Ed himself was able to slowly start climbing mountains. He said that after each climb he noticed his body working better. Two years later, 31-year-old Ed Jackson went up and down the stairs 2,783 times in his parents' house. This was the same height as the world's highest mountain near India. Later, he said he had loved doing it although it was sometimes painful and boring. By doing this climb, he raised a lot of money for *5charity. Ed hopes his story can help people. That's why he now works to support people facing troubles in life.
