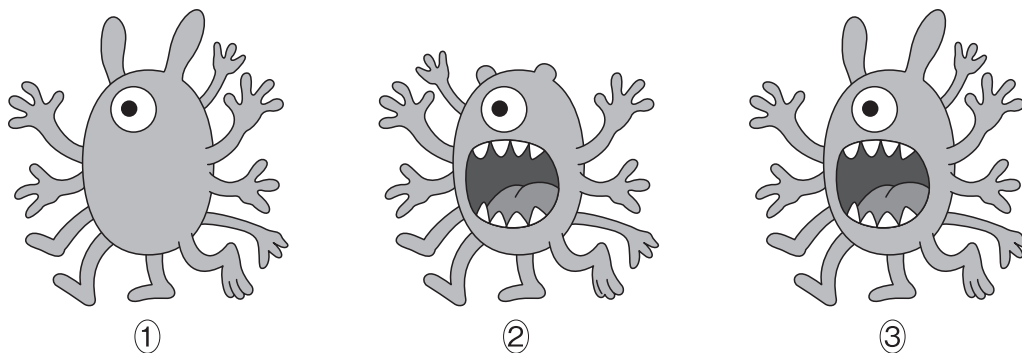

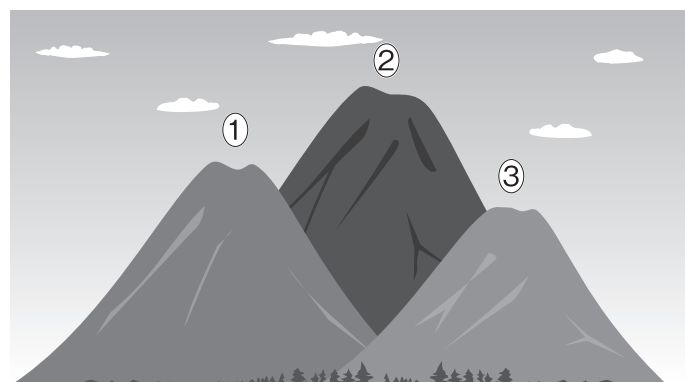

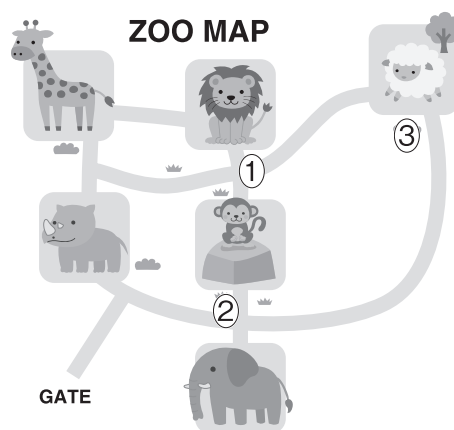

Akira Kurosawa is widely regarded as one of the most important film ^{*1}directors of the 20th century. His film *Rashomon*, which came out in 1950, won the first prize at an Italian film festival the next year. This success made Japanese movies well-known internationally for the first time.

Kurosawa's most famous film *Seven Samurai* appeared in 1954. The story is set in 1586, a time of many battles in Japan. A poor village is repeatedly attacked by a group of thieves who steal their rice. Some farmers decide to pay some money for protection to seven samurai without masters. The long training scenes and the final battle in heavy rain show honor, ^{*2}sacrifice, and differences between social classes. There are only three samurai left alive after the battle.

While Kurosawa admired some western films, a famous American film director, John Sturges, made ^{*3}*The Magnificent Seven* in 1960. Although it was based on Kurosawa's *Seven Samurai*, guns and village people in ^{*4}Mexico were used instead of ^{*5}swords and Japanese farmers. Today *Seven Samurai* is considered as one of the greatest films ever made and continues to influence directors all over the world.

Many kinds of businesses use ^{*1}bar codes. However, these are especially useful in supermarkets. One (①) is that most customers buy a large number of ^{*2}items. Bar codes make checkout faster and easier. (②), supermarkets sell many different kinds of items, and most of them sell quickly. Using bar codes allows stores to easily know what has been sold and what needs to be reordered. This makes store operations faster and smoother.

Before bar codes were invented, supermarket customers often waited in long lines. They waited for a clerk to add up the cost of the items they bought. First, the clerks picked up an item. Then, they searched for a price label and read the amount. (③), they entered the price into a ^{*3}cash register.

Sometimes the clerk made mistakes when reading the price, (④) slowed down the checkout ^{*4}process. Bar codes were invented to help stores speed up checkout. Now a clerk simply picks up an item and passes it over a ^{*5}scanner. The scanner reads the bar code, and the store computer searches its memory to find the matching bar code. Then it automatically enters the (⑤) price into the cash register.
